An additional twenty (\$20.00) Dollars will be charged for each set mailed. The Contractor is advised that to submit a bid on this project, the Contractor must have purchased a set of Plans and Specifications from Hubbell, Roth & Clark, Inc.

The proposal must be accompanied by a certified check or a cashier's check in the following amount: \$50,000.00. **NO BID BONDS WILL BE ACCEPTED.** Checks shall be made payable to the City of Troy. The bid deposit of the successful bidder shall be forfeited if he fails to execute a contract and supply the required bonds and insurance within thirty (30) calendar days after the award. No bid may be withdrawn for a period of sixty (60) calendar days after receipt of the bids.

The City reserves the right to accept any bids or reject any or all bids, to waive irregularities in any bid in the best interest of the City. Bids will be rejected for the following reasons:

- a) If the proposal does not contain a unit price for each item listed, except when there is only one unit of work; or
- b) If the bidder adds any provision reserving the right to accept or reject an award or to enter into a contract pursuant to an award.

No proposal will be received unless made on blanks furnished and delivered to the City Clerk on or before 2:00 p.m. local time, Tuesday, June 2, 2009.
